An easy-to-use design with a silhouette pattern and oversized punch handle makes adding a perfectly spaced border to any craft project quick and simple.

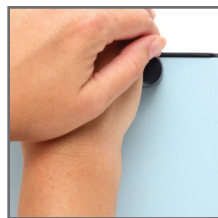
Border Punch

PUNCH BORDER DESIGNS



Center your paper

Center paper and slide it into the Border Punch, making sure it is flush to the back of the punch.



Depress handle

Push the oversized handle down all the way to cleanly punch the paper.



Slide your paper left or right

Slide the paper left or right until the pattern that was punched lines up with the silhouette pattern on the punch base.



Punch again

Punch again by depressing the handle just as on the first punch.



Repeat until the border is complete

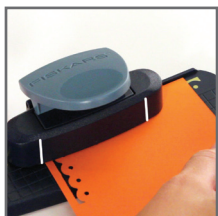
Continue to slide the paper to the left and right, aligning and punching until the border is complete.

TURN CORNERS



Insert corner

Most Border Punch designs effectively turn corners. To turn corners, insert one side of the corner of the paper even with the corner notch indicated on the punch. Punch by depressing the handle.



Flip paper

Flip the paper upside down, turn it 90 degrees and insert the other side of the corner so it is even with the corner notch on the punch. Punch by depressing the handle.



Repeat on other corners

Continue to rotate the paper, aligning and punching until the desired effect is achieved.

CREATE RIBBON EFFECTS



Punch strip

Punch along the length of a strip of paper using the steps described above in "Punch Border Designs." Strips 3/4" wide typically look best.



Punch other side

Turn the strip around and punch the other side in the same way in order to create a symmetrical ribbon design.



Repeat until the ribbon is complete

Continue to slide the paper to the left and right, aligning and punching until the ribbon is complete.

Tips, Tricks and Troubleshooting

Use the grid

Use the grid printed on the base of the Border Punch to accurately align paper. Grid marks are 1/4" apart.

Create perfect borders

Use the silhouette pattern on the base to align the next punch. Aligning the design that was just punched with the silhouette pattern on the base will ensure the border is evenly spaced around the paper.

Missed punch

If you accidentally miss a punch, use the silhouette pattern on the punch base to go back and add the punch to the appropriate spot.

Ribbon effects

Ribbon effects are particularly attractive with Hearts, Lace, Diamonds and Flowers Border Punch designs. Use different-colored paper and different types of paper to create different ribbon effects.

For use with up to 65-lb. cardstock

For best results, only use Border Punches on 65-lb. cardstock and lower.
